KEY STAGE 1 Junk Percussion

Create cross-curricular links between science and music by exploring sound & materials as children create their own instruments and learn a range of rhythms from samba to hip-hop to drum'n'bass.

KEY STAGE 2 Body Percussion with Literacy workshops

These workshops in conjunction with Pie Corbett are a fun, creative approach to literacy.

This kinaesthetic method allows children to gain both literacy & musical skills by exploring rhythmic elements of text then using body percussion to develop creative ideas focusing on the pulse, flow and emotion of words.
