Grandma Went to Market

A game for the whole family

One player starts by saying 'Grandma went to market to buy...' (add one item, for example potatoes).

The next player adds by saying 'Grandma went to market to buy potatoes and eggs.'

The next player adds again 'Grandma went to market to buy potatoes, eggs and a pair of shoes.'

Keep going, trying to remember as many items as you can. Each player can have more than one turn.

Have fun with this by changing the character, where they are going, what they are doing or by having a theme, for example Grandma buys only vegetables, or clothes, or sees (rather than buys) animals, or vehicles.
