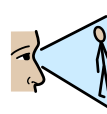




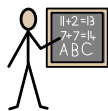
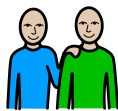
Back to school



School has been closed because of Coronavirus.



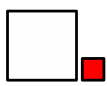
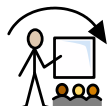
School is now open again for me and I can see some



of my friends and teachers.



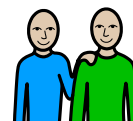
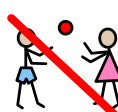
When I go back to school things will be different



I will be taught in a small group called a bubble.



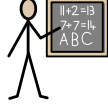

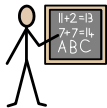
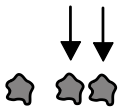
make me feel sad because I can't play with them,
