
ANTI-RACISM






PASTORAL & STUDENT WELLBEING

We have consciously avoided a menu titled 'Behaviour' or 'Behaviour Management'. We have formed a strong collaboration with Mark Finnis who heads up Relational Systems as a leading national provider of Restorative Practice. This aligns to the Education Department strategy of bringing Trauma Informed Practice to Enfield schools in a more consolidated way than before. We will work with schools on what else would support the relationships first approach. We are already working with the Education Endowment Foundation (EEF) on two programs. Particularly their first recommendation from their Improving Behaviour report is that: Every pupil should have a supportive relationship with a member of school staff.



We have given safeguarding its own menu as a demonstration of its importance. For the first time we are also offering professional learning under the three subcategories of compliance, curriculum and culture. Our key partner for compliance is Education Child Protection (ECP). We have commissioned a greater number of the basic programs with more regularity; aiming to reduce the costly arrangements that individual schools have been making until now. Under curriculum, we have an online safety consultant who will provide termly updates drawing on latest trends, research & resources to support schools. For child protection, DSL and online safety we have commissioned specific sessions for special schools or mainstream settings that are interested in the different needs of children and young people with SEND or vulnerabilities. Under the category of Culture, we have another first - we are working with Leo Powell who has expertise on County Lines and the issues this brings for young people. The two-session program he is delivering will look at developing understanding along with what schools can do to support the community.

The SEND/Inclusion Professional Learning Programme is developed by Enfield schools' trusted partners in the Local Authority. Training courses cover a broad range of special educational needs and disabilities that classroom practitioners will encounter. All programmes are led by outstanding providers from within Enfield or other nationally endorsed experts within their SEND/Inclusion specialism. The comprehensive programme is devised with local knowledge and aims to support school staff in responding to the challenges that practitioners face in their day to day work. School staff attending training will learn how to make their practice more inclusive, have higher expectations for their pupils with SEND and be better equipped to accelerate pupils' progress academically, socially and with their life skills.


