Learn how challenging behaviour, emotional distress and impairment in many areas of functioning in young people can be seen as a response to early trauma.

Understand how adults can begin to intervene in children and young people's lives in a meaningful and sequenced way to address their need for a sense of safety, skills to regulate their emotional/physical experience and addressing the gaps in their competencies.

Think together about how we plan the routines of the school day, reflect on our school ethos and environments, deliver the curriculum, develop our policies, communicate with and support our children, families, staff and whole community.
