- All successful pieces will be curated into an exhibition that will be shared through libraries and throughout the Civic Centre.
- An overall winning entry in each age category will be given an art supply hamper from Cass Art.

Poetry Writing Competition



The Queen's Green Canopy (QGC) is a unique tree planting initiative created to mark Her Majesty's Platinum Jubilee in 2022 which invites people from across the United Kingdom to "Plant a Tree for the Jubilee".

Tree planting will commence again in October 2022, through to the end of the Jubilee year. With a focus on planting sustainably, the QGC will encourage the planting of trees to create a legacy in honour of The Queen's leadership of the Nation, which will benefit future generations.

We would like to give children and young people in the London Borough of Enfield the chance to respond to this, to think and write creatively about the climate crisis and their response to the QGC project and its positive impact.

We are giving children and young people purpose, passion and a platform to write a poem. We hope that it will help them to fall in love with poetry and help them to express themselves through poetry.

How to Enter

What can your pupils win?

- Winning poems will be published online and in a printed LBE Poetry Anthology.
- An overall winning entry in each age category will receive a £30 book voucher

What sort of poem can pupils write?

- The poems can be in any poetry style you like (sonnet, limerick, haiku, villanelle, acrostic, rap)
- The poem should use the QGC as its inspiration. It could be about a new idea or discovery; how trees help the planet or just that pupils love trees.
- The poem should be a maximum of 35 lines.


