Enfield Council is looking for Lay and Education Panel members to sit on our School Appeal Hearings.

Who is a Lay person?

A lay person is someone who has not worked in any school in a paid capacity.

Examples of Lay members are: any member of the public (including someone who has previously been a school governor or a volunteer).

What would I be doing?

You would be sitting on a review panel with 2 or 4 other members making a careful decision about the outcome of a hearing and whether to uphold or dismiss an appeal that has been made.

Who is an Education person?

An education person is someone who has experience in education or the management of a school.

Examples of Education members are: parents of pupils currently registered at a school; Teachers; Governors or Head teachers.

Where?

Enfield Civic Centre or Virtually via Microsoft Teams

When?

Term time only (Monday to Friday)

Why?

To ensure all appeals are conducted in a fair and transparent way
