

# Mediated Learning Support Approaches (MeLSA) in Enfield Schools

**Enfield EPS is excited to launch MeLSA training, a psychologically informed approach with a growing evidence base.**

Mediation refers to structured support from adults that allows pupils to become independent thinkers.

This six-day training course is accessible and interactive, focusing on the psychological and skills of mediated learning.

Relevant to classroom teaching and learning, and to targeted and specialist intervention work, teachers and support staff will develop their skills in supporting children with cognition and learning needs.

Like our successful ELSA programme, MELSA-trained staff will also benefit from half termly supervision and termly network meetings facilitated by the Educational Psychology Service.
