Enfield Council is looking for Lay and Education Panel members to sit on our School Appeal Hearings.

What would I be doing?

You would be sitting on a panel with 2 or 4 other members making a balanced decision on whether to allow or refuse a parent's appeal against a decision not to offer their child a place at their preferred school.

Who is a Lay person?

A lay person is someone without any experience in education.

Examples of Lay members are any member of the public or someone who has not worked in any school in a paid capacity.

Who is an Education person?

An education person is someone who has experience in education or the management of a school.

Examples of Education members are: parents of pupils currently registered at a school; Teachers; Governors or Head teachers.

When? Term time only (Monday to Friday)

Why? To ensure all appeals are conducted in a fair and transparent way
