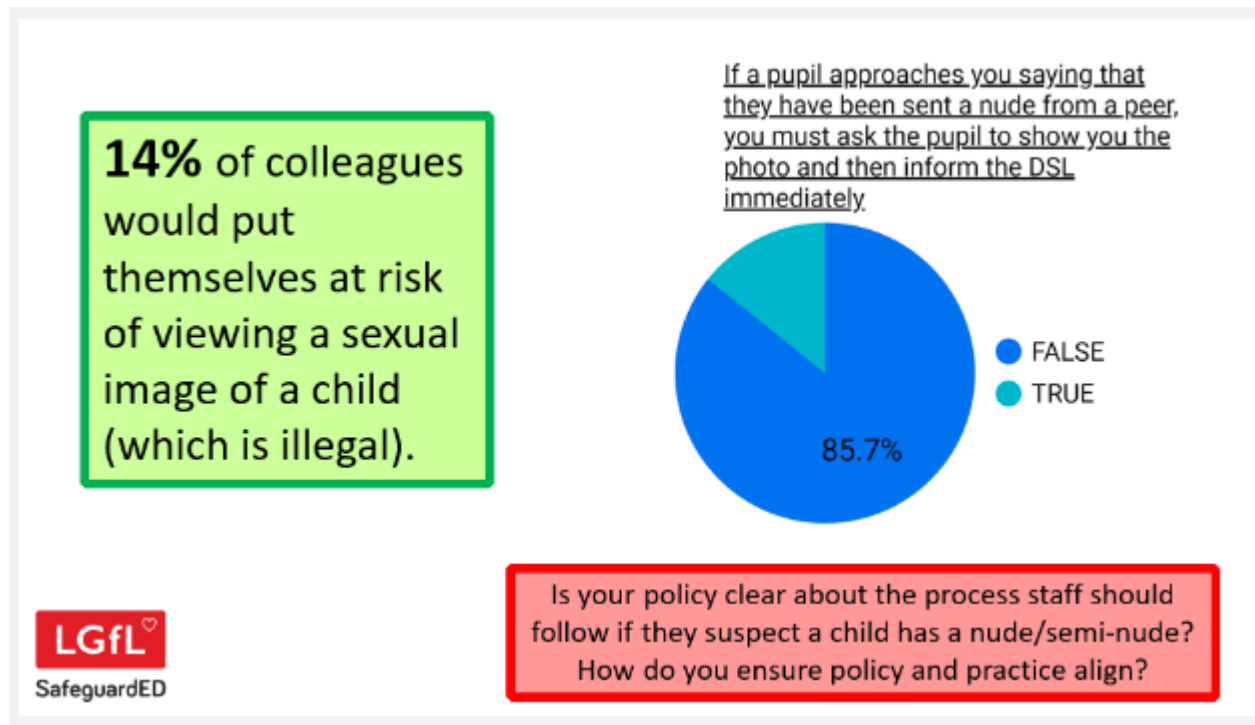

Measles


Vaccination rates in London have fallen below the threshold needed to prevent a Measles epidemic.


Measles is highly infectious and can be extremely dangerous. It can cause brain damage, lasting disability, hearing loss, and death.


Please support your families in securing updated inoculation against this very harmful disease.


It is also recommended that all adults check their own immunity status and act accordingly.

 **Measles: How to Stay Safe**






The best protection is 2 doses of the safe, effective MMR vaccine at 1 year of age, and 3 years, 4 months 

If you have not had two doses, you can get them **free** from your GP surgery 


Know the symptoms!
Keep people with symptoms away from others 

Call ahead before going to A&E or your GP 

Symptoms

- Rash 
- Temperature 
- Runny Nose 
- Red Eyes 
- Cough 

Complications of Measles



- Pneumonia
- Severe diarrhea
- Encephalitis
- Blindness
- Ear infection

Questions we've been asked this week

Q: We have a child going on a short term placement to another setting. What are our responsibilities?

A:

1. Inform the L.A. and follow advice
2. Ensure the setting is suitable. We would recommend a site visit and a conversation with the DSL
3. Ensure handover is robust and all safeguarding information has been shared
4. Ensure ongoing commitment from both settings is agreed. For example, both settings should attend and contribute to CiN and CP meetings
5. Ensure appropriate transition is in place for the child and family

PRICE training
