Key changes in this update

No statutory roles or functions have been removed

Increased emphasis on multi-agency working

Sets out what a good assessment (report) might include and has a useful annex of resources

Questions we've been asked this week

Q: Can a DBS be transferred from a new employee's other job?

There is not a simple answer. In short:

- You **should** apply for a new DBS for each new member of staff
- In some circumstances, a DBS can be ported if the previous industry and role is similar, and the DBS held is Enhanced. However, this ought to be temporary while awaiting your own setting's application, or registration with the update service
- You must, of course, still take 2 professional references

Q: Can you recommend anyone who can deliver workshops for parents on the topic of online safety?

The e-safety working party is exploring this. We will share what we find with you.
