

## Raising the Participation Age in Enfield (RPA)

The RPA relates to the requirement for all young people in England to continue in education, employment, or training until their 18th birthday.

The Participation and Inclusion Team delivers the council's statutory responsibility for the RPA and reports to the Department of Education, DfE.

Our key responsibility is to collect the destination data for all learners who are academic age of 17 and 18. This allows us to identify and support those learners who are not participating in education or training.

Below is an outline of our data collection cycle for the autumn term and interventions we provide to learners who are at risk of becoming NEET. All data should be submitted to [schoolsdata@enfield.gov.uk](mailto:schoolsdata@enfield.gov.uk) via Egress or any other secured data file platform **on or before the due date**.
