Supplementary Schools and Out of School Care

- If a club takes care of children under the age of 8 for more than 2 hours in any day for 14+ days of the year, it must register with Ofsted on the compulsory register and follow statutory guidance. There are a few limited exemptions: How to set up an activity club or other non Ofsted-registered club | Out of School Alliance

We are strongly recommending that schools:


- Share the poster

- Provide practical support for parents on how to set filters and parental controls on devices


