Developed with the help of primary-school aged children, the unique website has been created especially for children to learn about staying healthy and looking after their health.

The website features a diverse range of health topics from bullying to brushing teeth, allergies to bereavement. Children can learn more about these topics through the games, videos, and interactive content available on the website. The content has been written and overseen by experts from across NHS services including school nursing, health improvement, dietetics, paediatricians and mental health.

The Kids section of Health for Kids is presented through four themed worlds for children to explore - Staying Healthy, Feelings, Illness, and Getting help. Each 'world' presents health advice through fun facts, quizzes, games or film.
