Likely questions from link governor

- Are policies understood by everyone?
- Are staff confident about reporting children missing from education?
- How do you make sure that records are timely, up to date and stored securely? ~~Can I see a record?~~
- Are safer recruitment procedures in place?
- How is child on child abuse tackled?

Inspectors are likely to ask you about safeguarding

- ✓ How do you make sure policies are up to date and compliant?
- ✓ How do you check policies are implemented?
- ✓ How effectively does your school address general risks to children and risks that might be specific to the communities it serves (e.g. risk of female genital mutilation, (FGM), or radicalisation)?
- ✓ How safe do pupils feel, and how do you know?
- ✓ How well equipped are pupils to stay safe online?
