E-TIPSS invites schools and partners to the Summer Event, hosted by the Local Area Partnership.

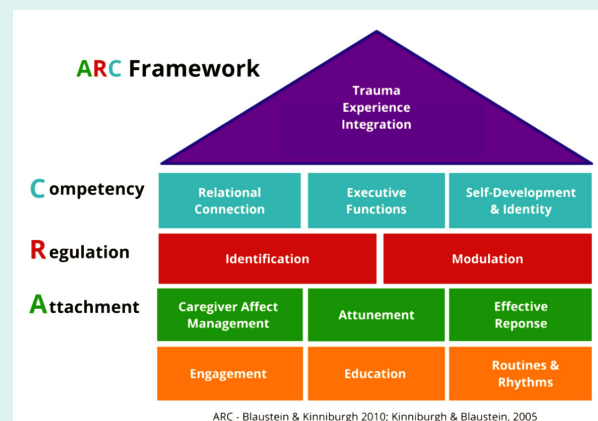
