1. Climate Action Plans & Support

- Schools are making good progress on Climate Action Plans, and it's encouraging to see many now completed or near completion.
- A key message from this session is that plans should be practical, regularly updated, and delivered through a whole-school approach.

- **EV Charging Grant (OZEV):**
 - Government grant available towards installation (now £2,000 per unit)
 - Extended until March 2027

- **Update School energy and capital projects:**
 - GLA's Green Schools funded projects now completed for the 4 selected schools
 - New pilots progressing (community energy + LED lighting)

3. Nature-Based & SUDS Projects

- Sustainable drainage (SuDS) schemes are progressing across multiple schools, with delivery planned this summer and next year, funded by the SuDS for Schools programme.
- Additional funding secured to expand delivery to more schools.
