PRICE RESTRAINT REDUCTION courses offer considered physical intervention techniques to support pupils in exceptional circumstances of escalating risk.

A small core programme of physical intervention techniques are presented in the context of **prevention-first approaches**, which promote a school's commitment to restraint reduction and Restraint Reduction Network (RRN) standards.

This course offers practical training, that is presented alongside:

- legal and ethical guidelines
- theoretical learning to support preventative responses.
- development of a school's strategic response to the challenges and risks arising from a pupil's presenting behaviour

The PRICE training offer to Enfield schools includes three options:

- “Closed” training days - only for staff within that school. Minimum of 9 delegates, maximum of 15 per trainer. Charge is £1,150 + VAT per 15 delegates. There is an additional charge of £38 + VAT for registration and certification. School will host the training.
- “Open” training days – open for delegates from various schools. Minimum of 9 delegates, maximum of 15 per trainer. Charge is £95 + VAT per delegate, plus an additional charge of £38 + vat for registration and certification. Host school will receive up to two gratis places on the course.
- “Train the trainer” courses. Schools can book this directly through PRICE. This training will be delivered by PRICE training. Please inform Primary Inclusion Team if you wish to take this option.

Schools will complete a “training needs analysis” before all training. This will need to be at least 4 weeks before the delivery of the training. For “open” courses each delegate will complete a “training needs analysis”. This will be summarised prior to the training, and informs the areas of focus for the training.

Any member of staff obtaining qualification through this training will need the support of the school's Senior Leadership to effectively implement its practices in school.

It is a requirement that each school has Senior Leadership representation, who have attended or are attending this training.

This training is delivered by members of the PRIMARY INCLUSION TEAM who are qualified PRICE Training trainers for mainstream schools.
